

**TOWN OF ROSSVILLE, TENNESSEE
ORDINANCE NO 2025-010**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CURRENT RATES FOR THE INSTALLATION OF RESIDENTIAL
IRRIGATION METERS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Rossville adopted a rate of \$500 for the installation of an irrigation meter, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Rossville recognized that the current rate was not covering the cost to perform this service; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Rossville in order to offer the service to the Town's residents all costs must be absorbed by the resident requesting this elective service.

Now, therefore, be it ordained by the Mayor and Board of Aldermen of the Town of Rossville, Tennessee, to amend Ordinance **2021-011** with the establishment of the following irrigation meter installation fees at the prevailing rate charged for the installation of a new development service connections and dedicated service tap lines:

Irrigation Meter	\$1,000
Dedicated Service Tap	Cost plus 15%


